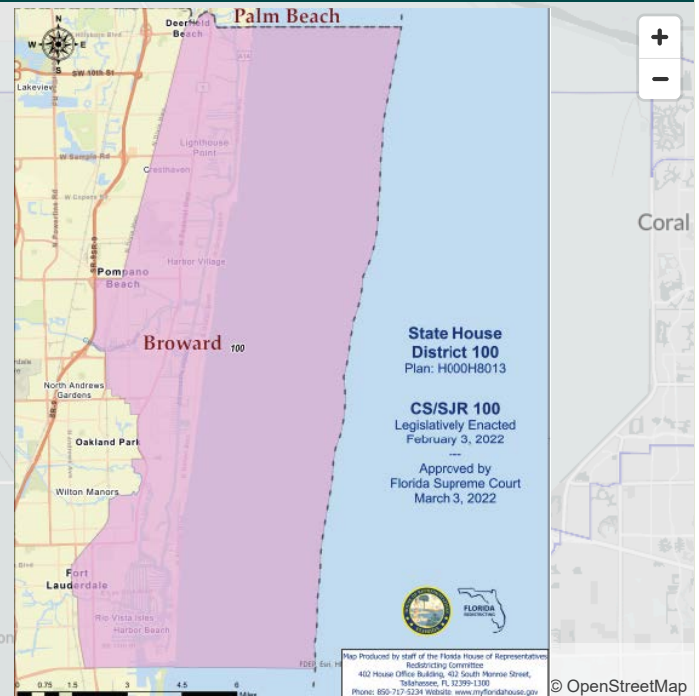

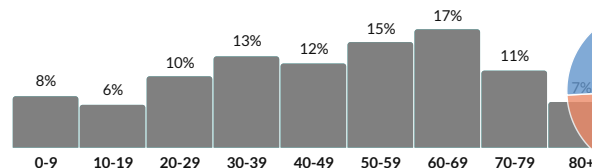

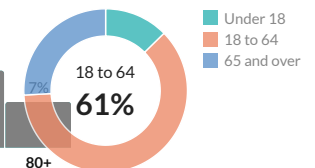

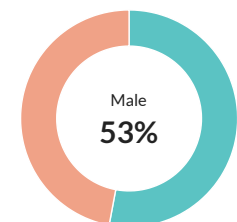


Population by age category

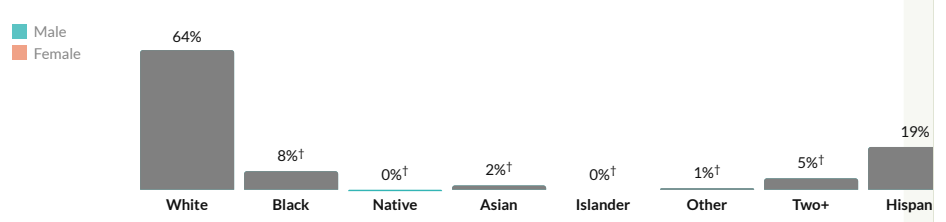

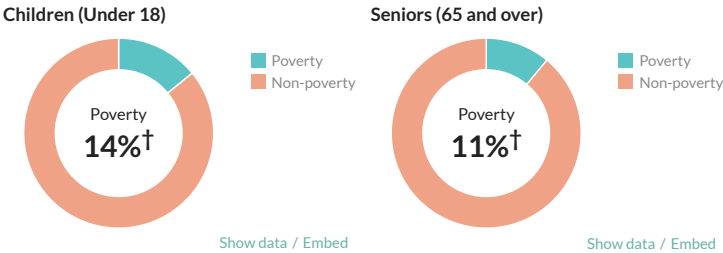

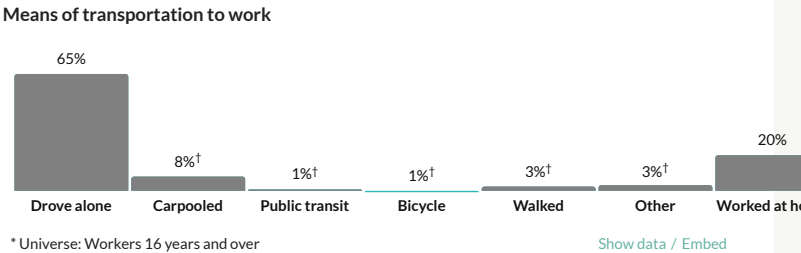

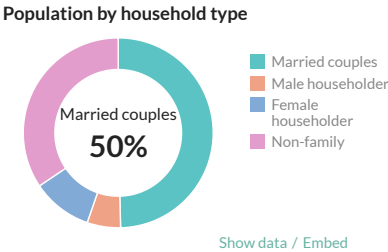

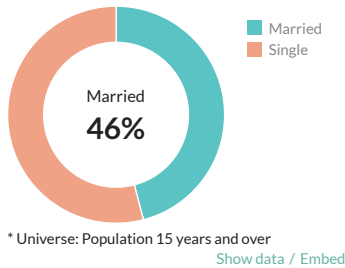

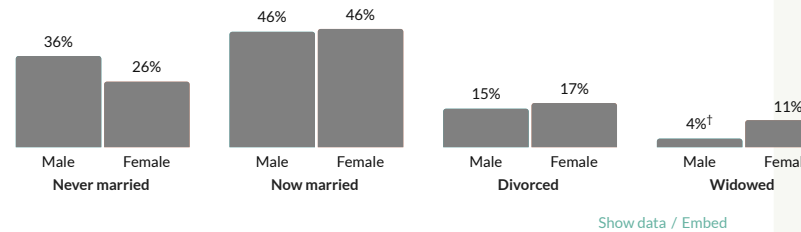

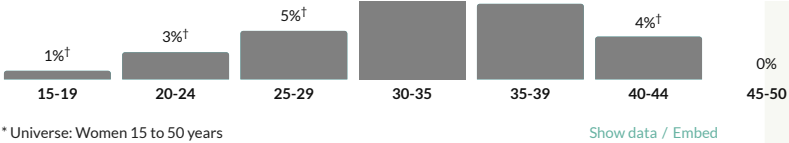

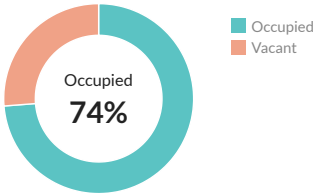

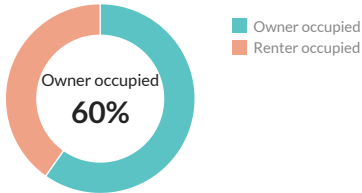

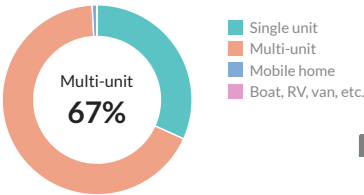
Occupied vs. Vacant



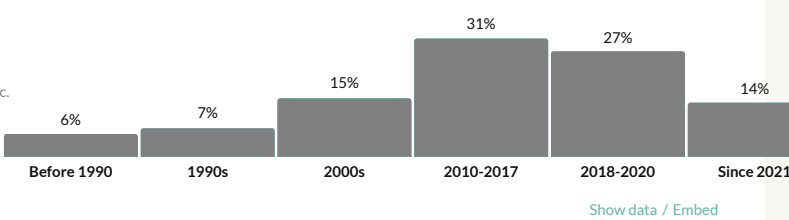
Ownership of occupied units

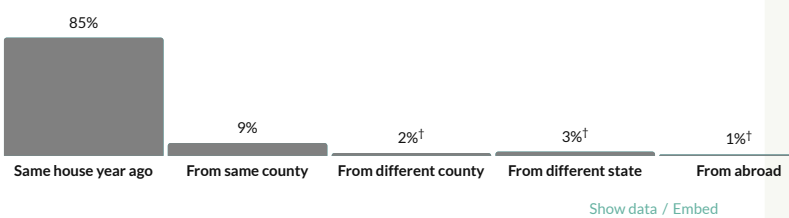

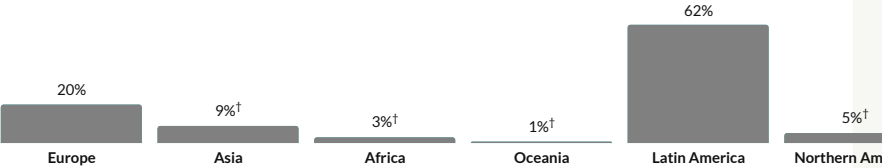

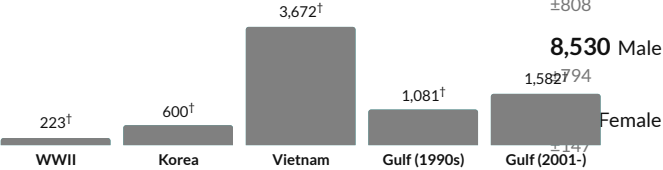
